This includes vessels equipped with integrated ballast tanks, wake-enhancing hull geometry, surf gates, trim tabs, or wake-shaping systems.
 - c. Any vessel that is equipped with artificial wake enhancement systems, such as any mechanical, electronic, ballast-based, or structural device intended to increase wake height, wave force, or wake displacement beyond normal vessel operation.
 - d. Any vessel altered from its factory configuration to increase wake size, such as through added ballast, hull appendages, wake-shaping devices, or similar equipment.
